# The Gran Risa slope

On the Gran Risa in La Villa, the great stars of skiing have met over the years. The great Alberto Tomba celebrated some of his great successes there and in addition to him, Ingemar Stenmark, Ted Ligety, Mark Girardelli, Bode Miller and Marcel Hirscher also triumphed on this slope. With its gradients and curves, the Gran Risa is considered among the most beautiful and technical slopes of the Alpine Ski World Cup and it is a challenge even for champions.

The descent starts just below the bifurcation of the black and red slopes of Piz La lla and extends through the forest above La Villa. Since it develops mostly to the north, the piste remains in the shade for the entire day. This makes it particularly hard and sometimes even icy. After overcoming the steep section at the beginning, a marked turn leads down a steep and narrow gully. The descent then leads to a second change of direction and to the end of the slope.

### Winter hike on the larch trail in San Cassiano

The themed "Tru di lersc" hike in San Cassiano offers visitors some exceptional views of the Dolomites. Along the way, you will have the opportunity to admire some interesting constructions that are in perfect harmony with the landscape, such as the traditional fences and dry stone walls. In some places, notice boards have been erected giving details of the characteristic features of some of the flowers and trees of the region, together with general information



about the flora, fauna and geology of the area.

The educational walk is reached from the church square in San Cassiano first following trail no. 15 east to the Maso Larjëi farm and then continuing on trail no. 15A to the Rü farm. The Tru di lersc nature trail begins to the left of the Rü farm. The trail winds through larch forests and Alpine meadows on the edge of the Fanes-Senes-Braies Natural Park until you reach the Maso Rüdeferia farm, where you can see a restored, working watermill.

Head back on trail no. 15 southwards to return to your starting point in San Cassiano.

# The Ladin flag

On 5th May 1920, representatives from all five Ladin valleys met on Passo Gardena to protest against the failure to take the Ladins into account in the peace treaty of St. Germain (1919) and the failure to grant them the right of self-determination. The Dolomite Ladin people were in fact clamouring for recognition as an ethnic-linguistic group. On that occasion, the Ladin flag was carried for the first time in the Dolomites.

The colours are strongly reminiscent of the nature of Ladinia: the green of the meadows and fir forests, the white of the snow covering the Dolomites, as well as the Dolomites themselves. known for their whiteness, and the blue of the sky.

Later on, Fascism no longer accepted the Ladin minority language and the Ladin flag was declared illegal. It was hoisted again on the Sella Pass on 14 July 1946 where once again 3000 Ladins, after the Second World War, put forward their demands for administrative unity and the right to self-determination. It was precisely in that period that the reform process began, which has produced many different forms of protection and promotion of the Ladin linguistic minority.
