Hike to the Puez - Odle UNESCO Nature Park

Hike in the Puez-Odle Nature Park, particularly interesting from a geological point of view.

Turn-by-turn directions

From the parish church in Colfosco, walk westwards on trail no. 4 through the Stella Alpina valley. The trail takes you past an old wayside shrine and westwards up to the highest corrie with the Ciampëi lake (2,173 m), which is often dried up. Passing to the left of the lake, you climb uphill, with a very steep final section, up to the Forcela Ciampëi passage. Here you keep to the right, following trail no. 2 (part of the Dolomites Alpine Ridgeway no. 2, which goes from Bressanone in South Tyrol to Feltre in Veneto) and climbing up a rocky gully to the Puez Plateau. Continuing on trail no. 2, you cross the plateau, going north-west and gradually uphill, to the Puez hut (2,475 m). The descent to Colfosco follows the same route, which takes about 1 hour 50 minutes.

Difficulty: moderate
Duration: 5h



Legends and tales of the Dolomites

In Ladin families, there used to be more time to tell stories, especially during the winter months, which were spent mostly at home. It was on these occasions that the many folk tales were handed down from generation to generation.

These told of positive figures such as the "salvans" and the "ganes", but also of evil ones such as witches, dragons and orcs.

Veiled in the mists of legend, the stories of the Dolomites do not allow us to distinguish between "history" and "legend", but they guide us toward discovering the delicate relationship between the people and the land and using our imagination to provide an explanation of natural phenomena. Even today many Ladin locations bear names drawn from Ladin legends.

The legends of the Ladins are at the core of the Dolomite legends, carefully collected by Karl Felix Wolff and published for the first time in 1905.
